- Operate plant, equipment and tools in a safe manner according to all relevant legislation and company procedures
- Perform daily safety check and maintenance checks on plant and equipment prior to use and recording of such checks
- Advise the Operations Director/ Workshop & Plant Manager of any requirements for non-routine maintenance/ repairs via Weekly Plant Return Form
- Ensure equipment is safe and secure whilst not in operation
- Maintain workplace in accordance with company health, safety and environmental procedures and standards
- Wear appropriate PPE
- Report accidents and near misses in line with company procedures
- Follow quality procedures and highlight opportunities for improvement
- Works including anything as required by the requirements of the site including manual labour.
- Must work to a high standard and be able to work productively and safely of your own when necessary
